As a member of the 123 Grow Child Development Centre, you will work with children, families and other supports within the agency and community. The program will use an evidence-based [*child care curriculum framework](#). This program was developed by early learning and child care educators, early childhood academics, government, and professionals working in related fields. It is designed to foster improved early childhood development outcomes so children can get the best possible start to life.

All employees are required to have a current (within 6 months) Criminal Record Check and Intervention Record Check through Children's Services. We strongly recommend that you start this process before you apply for a job at ABC Head Start Society as it is a condition of employment.
