ABC Head Start offers a comprehensive preschool and family support program for low income families. Operating in 6 locations across Edmonton, our goal is to prepare children for a successful educational experience in partnership with the family and community. Children in the ABC Head Start program are from 2 ½ to 5 years.

Responsibilities:

- Work collaboratively with families of children with severe delays (Program Unit Funding – PUF) to enhance learning, skills and competencies across lived environments (home, school and community)
- Conduct weekly home visits, plans and implements play based activities that foster growth and learning, and connects with the children and the classroom team on a weekly basis.

Qualifications:

- A diploma (2 year) Early Learning and Child Care, Special Needs Assistant, Teacher Assistant from a recognized educational institution
- Related experience working with pre-school children is required
- Experience working with children with complex needs is required
- Experience with home visitation is a definite asset
- Fluency in languages other than English is a definite asset
- Equivalent education and experience will be considered
- Valid Driver's license and access to a vehicle
